


We have to believe we will get there and also remember that we are in this together. Because it is our collective actions that will create the sweeping waves that will transform our world.

Undocumented and Unafraid, Queer and Unashamed

There's a belief that in many Latinx immigrant communities, our families won't accept us as LGBTQ+. But during my coming out experience, I have never felt more connected to my immigrant community.

In 2012, I was at an immigration solidarity march where I was going to share my story about being undocumented. I remember thinking: "I'm not going to come out as queer. I don't want them to know."

But when I walked on stage, I knew what I had to do. I said: "I'm undocumented and unafraid, queer and unashamed." And I said it in Spanish.

Las abuelas, las tias, los tios—all the people who were there shouted: "YES, mijo! I'm so proud of you!"

After that, I started living openly in all parts of my life as an undocumented trans woman, fighting at the juncture where my worlds overlap.

I've been in the United States for 25 years, since I was 2 years old. This is my life. This is my country.



Undocumented students like me cannot access financial aid, so I paid my entire tuition at the University of Washington out of pocket. I sold hotdogs outside of Neighbors Nightclub four days a week, from 10pm to 5am, to make extra money.

I got my first scholarship from Pride Foundation in 2013. It not only helped me cover tuition costs—it showed me that an entire organization was working to support students like me. This scholarship was the beginning of a long and multi-faceted relationship with Pride Foundation. *continued on next page...*

Fueling Change continued

I'm now a coordinator for the Washington Immigrant Solidarity Network (WAISN), a Pride Foundation grantee. We are the largest immigrant-led statewide coalition building a defense line for immigrant and refugee communities.

Alongside Pride Foundation and a network of organizations across Washington, we are supporting LGBTQ+ immigrants and refugees in detention centers, where LGBTQ+ detainees are 15 times more likely to be assaulted, and are often placed in solitary confinement.²

We are building broader community support by finding sponsors to provide housing to the detainees who are released from custody—making it possible for asylees fleeing persecution to find safety and support while they continue their legal journey.

For the first time, all of my identities are part of this project. And through projects like this one, it is making it more clear that immigrant justice *is* LGBTQ+ justice.

In my organizing work, I often end our days with a chant from Assata Shakur to remind us why we are doing this work together:

"It is our duty to fight for freedom.

It is our duty to win.

We must love each other and protect each other.

We have nothing to lose but our chains."

I'm so grateful for that moment when I came out on stage in 2012—and for the outpouring of support I've experienced since. I'm still proud to say that I'm undocumented and unafraid, queer and unashamed—and to get to work so other people can feel safe to say it too.



Since 1985, we have fought for a world where everyone in our communities can be our whole selves in all the places we call home—regardless of zipcode.

Today, we remain committed to shifting cultural acceptance and advancing our legal rights through:

- Sharing our stories to build empathy and broaden understanding of LGBTQ+ people and our lives.
- Lifting up the full lived experiences and diversity of our community.
- Mobilizing strong local networks where our communities are seen, valued, and heard.
- Advancing policies that ensure all LGBTQ+ people have full lived and legal equality.

True progress means that culture must meaningfully change alongside our legal victories. Together, we are shifting understanding and acceptance by sharing the stories of our lives.

Our Word is Our Bond

"In Samoa, oral tradition and storytelling is the fabric of our culture. Before colonization, we passed down our history through song, oration, and acknowledgements from generation to generation," explains Manumalo Ala'ilima, co-chair of United Territories of Pacific Islanders Alliance Portland (UTOPIA PDX), an all-volunteer organization that provides sacred spaces for Queer and Trans Pacific Islanders (QTPIs).

UTOPIA PDX, a Pride Foundation grantee, hosts a storytelling series called 'Talanoa', which from Samoan loosely translates as 'our word is our bond.' These events are an opportunity for QTPIs to share their stories and perspectives related to timely issues, and publicly lift up voices that are often excluded from the narrative of what it means to be LGBTQ+.

The Talanoa series and other similar storytelling approaches from Indigenous organizations are culturally-rooted models to building a richer understanding of LGBTQ+ communities.

In all movements that work to build public support and understanding, determining what stories are told, how they are told, and who tells them is critical to making real change.



"When we're facing harmful legislation, there is incredible pressure to find messaging quickly that will most effectively sway the general public and combat the narratives being used against us," explains Isyss Agaiotupu Honnen, Project Director of Pride Foundation's public education and policy advocacy program, TRANSform Washington. "When we are not in the midst of a legislative attack, we have the opportunity to broaden public understanding of the full diversity and lived experiences of LGBTQ+ communities." *continued on next page...*

Sharing Our Stories continued

Working in partnership with Transgender Law Center and a network of trans and gender diverse people and organizations from across the country, we are working to do just that.

Together, we are asking: What if public education efforts in response to legislative attacks mirrored the diverse perspectives of UTOPIA PDX's Talanoa series? And what if those most impacted by injustice were the ones to develop the messaging tools and strategies to drive our movements for justice forward?

"There are critical messaging ideas within our own communities that we can use to build out grassroots organizing strategies based in storytelling," Isyss affirms.

With generous support from a national funder, we are researching messaging strategies to find ways to build public understanding and empathy for non-binary people—and ensuring it is community-driven and infused with Indigenous values every step of the way.

Alongside these community partners, we are creating storytelling and messaging toolkits that will be shared with grassroots organizations across the region and country that they can then tailor to their own communities and use in their work to shift hearts and minds.

Integral to this work is continuing to support and nurture the grassroots storytelling efforts of indigenous groups like UTOPIA PDX. Together, we know we can build empathy through authentic storytelling—and genuinely shift understanding and acceptance of the breadth of people in our communities.



Driving Movements

Since 1985, Pride Foundation has held a vital role in the LGBTQ+ movement in the Northwest.

Today, we continue to drive transformative movements as a funder, connector, convener, collaborator, and advocate through:

- Elevating opportunities in philanthropy to deepen investments in LGBTQ+ communities.
- Supporting movement leaders, while building a bigger table that has seats for everyone.
- Collaborating to build networks across movements, sectors, and geographic regions.



In order to thrive, our leaders and organizations require support that is broad and deep. Together, we are strengthening the networks of LGBTQ+ leaders, advocates, and communities across the Northwest who are driving our movements forward.

Open To All: Businesses Driving Change in Montana

When Erica Brubaker lived in Colorado, she canvassed door-to-door to fight for the issues and causes she cared about most.

Now, as the owner of Wild Joe's Coffee Spot in Bozeman, Montana, she takes a different tactic.

"I get to create change right in my business," Erica explains. "It's a new and productive way I can influence change in Montana. Honestly, it's been one of the best parts of being a business owner."

Erica and her husband, Ryan, have owned Wild Joe's for 3 years, and openness and inclusivity have been driving forces since day one.

"Providing a safe space for everyone that walks in the door is our top priority—including things like gender neutral restrooms," she explains.

Erica joined Pride Foundation's supportive business initiative, *Open to All*, so that she could live out her values as a business owner publicly. She wants everyone in town to know that they will be treated with respect in her shop, whether they work there or are stopping in for a cup of coffee.



"We have 14 employees, and one of the reasons people tell us they want to work here is that it's a welcoming, open space. We are passionate about treating every single person who walks through our doors equally—regardless of race, sexual orientation, gender identity, or income level."

Open to All began in 2016 to strengthen the network of businesses and organizations committed to creating safe spaces for all LGBTQ+ people who live, work, and visit Montana. Since then, more than 250 businesses, non-profits, and community groups have joined. continued on next page...

Driving Movements continued

In places like Alaska, Idaho, and Montana where LGBTQ+ people do not have statewide non-discrimination protections and can still be discriminated against legally, collaboration across sectors is critical to creating a better, safer world for LGBTQ+ people.

Pride Foundation has also deepened partnerships with two of our grantees in Bozeman—Montana Racial Equity Project and Bridgercare—to ensure racial, disability, and gender justice are prioritized with participating business owners. Together, these organizations have empowered an additional 60+ businesses to join the initiative.

"We are helping to show that all of our issues and communities are intertwined, and that the LGBTQ+ community in Montana is incredibly diverse," Kim Leighton, Pride Foundation's Regional Officer in Montana, explains. "LGBTQ+ people hold many identities—our community is made up of people of color, people living with disabilities, and more. These identities are not separate."

Over the coming years, Pride Foundation hopes to expand support for businesses participating in *Open to All* through network-building opportunities, trainings, informational newsletters, and supporting efforts to make their spaces even more welcoming and affirming.

When Erica reflects on Wild Joe's future involvement with *Open to All,* her answer is simple:

"I want to help create a city where people feel welcomed as they are. We have to be open—as businesses, and as people—if we want to grow."

In 1985, we were founded with a simple, yet visionary idea: *Giving together, building community.*

Opening Doors for LGBTQ+ Latinx Students

Growing up in rural Yakima Valley in Central Washington, Kris Gonzalez remembers her father and his family working in fields cutting turnips, asparagus, grapes, and the toll this labor took on them.

"My grandparents were immigrants from Mexico who faced a lot of hardships. Growing up, there were a lot of doors that were not open to me—I didn't even know there were doors."

"Looking back, I know I wouldn't be who I am today without my grandmother, Edna," Kris reflects. "She believed in me wholeheartedly. When I cut my hair short and changed my name to Kris at age four, she supported me."

Edna believed education was the key that would open doors, and this inspired Kris to become a teacher. Kris's path, though, was not without struggle. She was closeted for 17 years out of fear of being fired.

"Eventually, I came out because I believed it was my responsibility to show my students that they could be exactly who they are," Kris explains.

Kris's commitment to supporting students extends beyond her classroom. In 2015, she joined a Pride Foundation scholarship review committee focused on supporting Latinx youth.

"The experience of reading their applications reminds me of my history and the legacy I want to leave in this world," Kris reflects.

Inspired by her grandmother, the stories of Latinx students, and supported by the generosity of family and friends, Kris recently started the Edna Earl Education Scholarship for Latinx LGBTQ+ and allied students studying education.


